GLOSSARY

| NOPT | Not phage typed. |
| RDNC | Reacts with the phages but does not conform to a recognised pattern of lysis. |
| UNTY phages | A culture which does not react with any of the in the typing scheme. |
| Untyped | Full information unavailable at the time of data collation. |
| Untypeable | A culture which is not suitable for typing. |
| Structure only | Some cultures may be non-motile or fail to express Both flagella antigens in the case of di-phasic serotypes, and consequently cannot be named. In such cases the antigenic structure is reported or isolates are grouped as “structure only”. |
| Rough | Rough strains of <i>Salmonella</i> cannot be serotyped due to autoagglutination. |
| DT | Definitive Phage Type of <i>S. Typhimurium</i> as described by Anderson et al (1977). |
| PT | Phage type |
| U | Undesignated. A recognised phage designation with a particular pattern of lysis which has not yet been included in the typing scheme eg. U302 |
| Cfi | Centre for Infections (previously CDSC) |
